Corrections and changes to the Diptera Checklist (50) - Editor

It is intended to publish here any corrections to the text of the latest Diptera checklist (publication date was 13 November 1998; the final cut-off date for included information was 17 June 1998) and to draw attention to any subsequent changes. All readers are asked to inform me of errors or changes, and I thank all those who have already brought these to my attention.

Changes are listed under families; names new to the British Isles list are in bold type. The notes below refer to the addition of 13 species and loss of one due to synonymy, resulting in a total of **7259** species (of which 39 are recorded only from Ireland).

An updated version of the checklist, incorporating all corrections and changes that have been reported in *Dipterists Digest*, is available for download from the Dipterists Forum website. It is updated following publication of each issue of *Dipterists Digest*.

Ceratopogonidae. The following species is added in the present issue (p. 246): *Atrichopogon (Meloehelea) atriscapulus* Kieffer, 1918

Tachinidae. The following species are added in the present issue: *Gymnocheta magna* Zimin, 1958 (p. 145) *Gymnocheta lucida* Zimin, 1958 (p. 218)

Changes to the Irish Diptera List (35) – Editor

This section appears, whenever necessary, to keep up to date the initial update of the Irish list in *Dipterists Digest* Vol. **10**, 135-146 and the latest checklist of Irish Diptera (Chandler, P.J., O'Connor, J.P. and Nash, R. 2008. *An annotated checklist of the Irish two-winged flies (Diptera)*. 261 pp. The Irish Biogeographical Society in association with The National Museum of Ireland).
